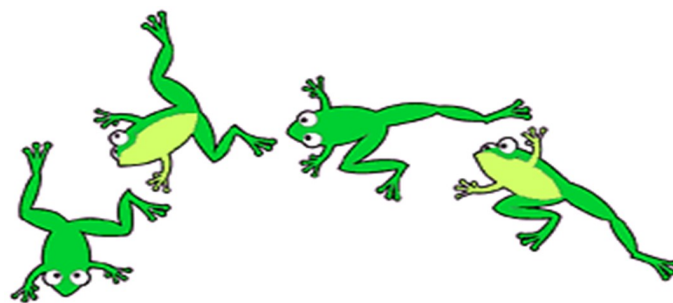

enjoy!

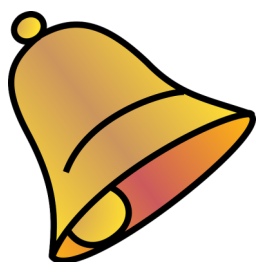
