The member of the public made observations of the Planning Committee decision which had granted temporary planning permission on the site in question. He considered the meeting had not been managed well by officers and the chair and on several occasions the discussions focused on considerations which did not appear to merit material weight when assessing the application. The member of the public was very disappointed with the process and feared a similar situation would take place again. The Chair thanked the member of the public and explained the Parish Council had held meetings with planning officers over the last year. He strongly recommended the photos be sent to the planning officer. General discussion took place regarding the merits of delegated decisions against Committee decision.
