132/23 Climate Change, Sustainability and Biodiversity

The Chair and Cllr Holland updated Councillors on the planning for the Big Green Day. Promotion and confirmation of exhibitors were the key areas being worked on.

133/23 Action Plan 2023/2024

Councillors reported on the site meeting at Spunhill junction with A528 held with representatives of Ellesmere Rural Parish Council, Shropshire Council (members and officers) and West Mercia Police. It had been organised to review the safety of the junction following the fatal accident earlier in 2023. Councillors reported that the meeting had been very positive and the dangers at the junction were acknowledged. It was agreed the Clerk would thank the Traffic Management officers and enquire when the proposal for solutions would be available.

Updates to the Plan were noted.

134/23 Councillor Reports

All meetings which Councillors had attended had been reported earlier in the meeting.

135/23 Parish Matters

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Cllr Dinsdale reported on an event being held at The Sun on 26 August, the proceeds from which would be donated to the Parish Hall.

Cllr Wellsbury reported that Community Payback who helped with the maintenance of Welshampton's churchyard had not been as active as previous years. The PCC was seeking additional help with the maintenance.

The request from the campaign group Shropshire Defend Our NHS to support its latest initiative 'Rural Shropshire needs NHS care too!' was noted and agreed.

136/23 Highways.

Cllr Withington followed up the discussion on Spunhill junction with comments regarding the general safety of the A528 between Ellesmere and Harmer Hill. There were limited overtaking sections and blind corners. He considered the whole stretch, not just the Spunhill junction, to be dangerous. Although there were central white and double white lines within the 40mh limits, there were long stretches with no white lines. Cllr Withington proposed the Council approach Shropshire Council for a review of the A528 and contact Parish Councils along the A528 for support. This was agreed.
